Casa Grande – January 22, 2019, The United Way of Pinal County family announces the departure of Mannie Bowler as Executive Director.

During her tenure in Pinal County, communities have embraced the Heat Relief Network water drive, homeless coalitions and the Project Connect events, the Keep on Wheelin' bike program, reading by third grade efforts, including the Dolly Parton Imagination Library, Feed Pinal and the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Program. In working to LIVE UNITED, each community has developed a focus area that the United Way of Pinal County supports. Through this collaboration of nonprofits, business, government and local investors, the UWPC has been allowed to weave the programming into the fabric of each community.

Bowler accepted a position outside of the region due to family circumstances and will leave on Feb. 14. A transition period is being developed to ensure all United Way programs continue uninterrupted.

"We wish Mannie continued success, both personally and professionally," said Gregg Bargo, president of the UWPC board of directors. "She has left an indelible mark on the United Way of Pinal County. In her time here, she has spearheaded many positive changes to the organization.
