SRP Supports Financial Literacy Through United Way & University of Arizona

United Way of Pinal County is working with University of Arizona – Pinal County Cooperative Extension to offer no-cost financial education classes to Pinal County, both online and in-person. Salt River Project (SRP) has awarded a \$25,000 grant to United Way of Pinal County to help fund these classes and ensure they can be accessed by residents of Pinal County.

Courses are currently available midday and evenings and focus on the basics of budgeting, understanding where your money goes, and learning to live within your means.

Introductory classes include *Online Lunch-n-Learn* every Wednesday from 12pm-1pm (virtual) and *Where Does Your Money Go?* on select Thursday evenings from 6pm-8pm (virtual). The *Online Lunch-n-Learn* sessions cover different topics from *Building Financial Security* and *Where Does Your Money Go?* workshops. *Where Does Your Money Go?* Sessions cover how to make a budget that works for you and saving for the future.
